**DESCRIPTION:** mrdh® is a soft, white, sterile, non-woven, lyophilized pad of a cellulosic polymer isolated from microalgae (poly-N-acetyl glucosamine). It is attached to x-ray detectable gauze and packaged in a sterile blister pack.

**INDICATIONS:** mrdh® is intended for use under the direction of a healthcare professional.

mrdh® is a trauma dressing intended for the temporary control of severely bleeding wounds such as surgical wounds (operative, postoperative, donor sites, dermatological, etc.) and traumatic injuries.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

There are no known contraindications to the use of mrdh®.

**mrdh® APPLICATION:**

1. Open sterile blister pack.
2. Place mrdh® on open wound, with active side toward wound surface.
3. Apply firm hand compression until bleeding stops.
4. If the dressing becomes completely soaked through, apply another dressing over the first and continue pressure.

**TO REMOVE:**

1. Soak mrdh® with sterile saline.
2. Gently peel away.
