### Uses

For relief of occasional constipation (irregularity).  
This product generally produces a bowel movement within 12 to 72 hours.

### Warnings

Do not use if you are presently taking mineral oil unless told to do so by a doctor

### Ask a doctor before use if you have

- stomach pain • nausea • vomiting
- noticed a sudden change in bowel habits that lasts over 2 weeks

### Stop use and ask a doctor if

- you have rectal bleeding or fail to have a bowel movement after use. These could be signs of a serious condition.
- you need to use a laxative for longer than one week

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a doctor before use.  
**Keep out of Reach of Children.**

In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

### Directions

- Adults and children 12 years of age and older: take 1 tablet as needed, not to exceed 3 tablets daily, or as directed by a doctor
- Children under 12 years of age: consult a doctor before use
- Tablets may be swallowed whole or crushed and mixed with food

### Other information

- Each tablet contains: calcium 40 mg, sodium 10 mg
- Store at room temperature in a dry place

**Inactive ingredients** Croscarmellose Sodium, Dicalcium Phosphate, Hypromellose, Magnesium Stearate, Microcrystalline Cellulose, Polyethylene Glycol, Pregelatinized Starch, Silica, Sodium Benzoate, Stearic Acid
