Presentation

Hygienic cover® – vomit bag containing a super absorbent pad which gelifies bodily fluids and reduces odours. It is used in association with the Hy21® vomit support.

Cover dimensions

Length = 9.8"- (25 cm). Width = 9.8"- (25 cm). Thickness = 38µm.

Composition

Polyethylene bag equipped with ties. Super absorbent pad 100% recycled composed of a non-woven support with a sulfate base coupled with sodium acrylate based co-polymers. Packaging made of recycled materials. No latex and no phthalates.

Shelf life

No expiry date.

Efficiency

Absorption of 600 ml of liquids in less than 30 seconds.

Manufacturing process

Heat welding of plastic film with insertion of ties.

Use

For any person, men or women, experiencing vomiting, whether in a health care institution, at home or during a trip. Particularly recommended for oncology services, dialysis, post-operative recovery room, as well as for emergency services, such as ambulances.

Instructions for use

Open the packet and take out a bag.

Open the bag and verify the presence of the super absorbent pad at the bottom of the bag.

Place the bag on the emesis support.

Vomit into the bag.

Wait for the gelification of the liquids (± 600 ml within seconds).

Close the bag, tie it closed and discard in the appropriate location.

Refer to the usage instructions for more detail.

Precautions for use

Single-use product. Do not reuse. Keep away from children.

Disposal

Dispose of product in regular waste or according to the protocol of the institution. Don't dispose in toilet.

Benefits

Protection for vomit support. Limits the spread of pathogens.

Increases hygiene, disposable product, saves time, reduces odours, simple and risk-free disposal.

Improved replacement of the kidney tray or paper bag.

Identification

Each product is identified with a lot number.

Quality

Our bags are tested using the methodology and acceptance criteria of standard NF-X30-501: *Packaging for medicinal care waste – Bags for soft infections risk-generating waste – Specifications and tests methods.*

Regulatory

FDA: class I medical device exempt from 501(k).

CE marking: Class I medical device according to the rules of annex IX of European Council Directive 93/42/EEC.

Risks/Safety

Very slight risk of ocular or respiratory irritation in case of extended contact with the super absorbent pad. Safety data sheet is available upon request.

Handling/Storage

Store in a clean and dry place, away from sun.
